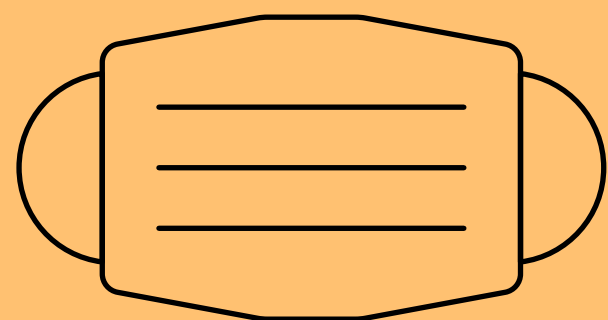


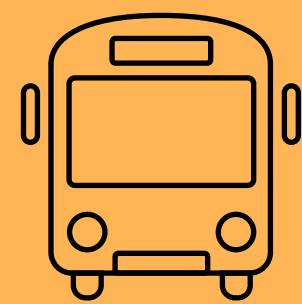
Confederation imposes tougher measures to combat coronavirus

From 19 October the following rules apply nationally:

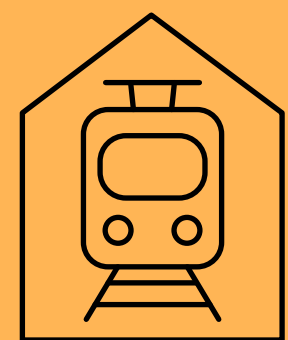


Mandatory mask-wearing extended

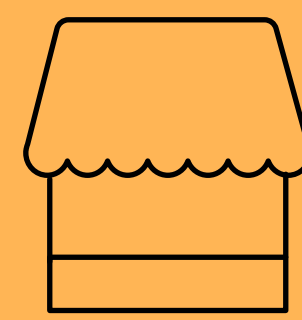
It is now mandatory to wear a mask in all publicly accessible buildings and inside spaces.

and friends of 16 to 100 persons:

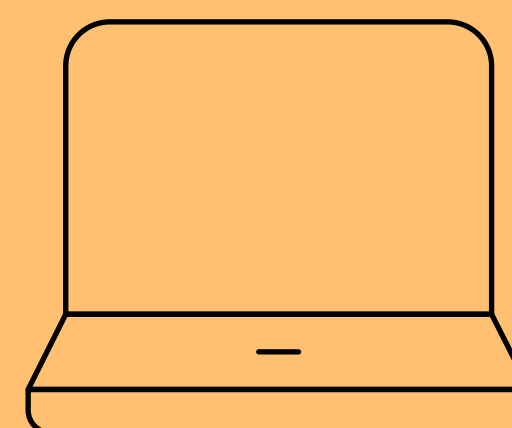
- Masks must be worn

Hospitality venues: food and drink seated only

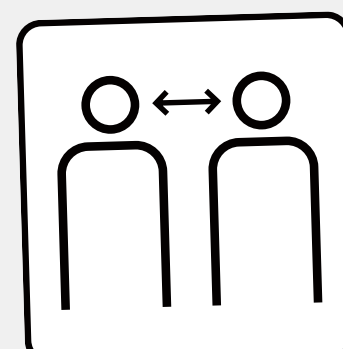
In restaurants, bars, clubs and

(inside and outside).



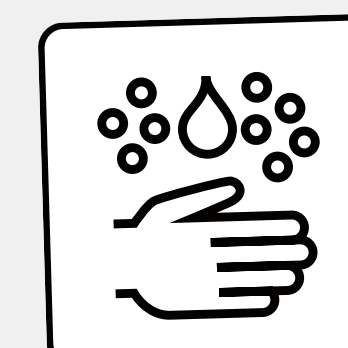
