
Confederation imposes tougher measures to combat coronavirus

From 19 October the following rules apply nationally:




Mandatory maskwearing extended

It is now mandatory to wear a mask in all publicly accessible buildings and inside spaces.



Public transport (as before)



Sports facilities (Entrance and changing rooms) concert venues hospitals



Stations incl. platforms, airports



Gatherings



Spontaneous gatherings of more than 15 persons in public areas are not permitted.



Rules for gatherings of family and friends of 16 to 100 persons:

- Masks must be worn
- Contact details must be recorded
- Food and drink may be consumed seated only

100 persons or more: set of precautionary measures



Hospitality venues: food and drink seated only


In restaurants, bars, clubs and dance halls, food and drink may only be consumed seated (inside and outside).



Recommendations for working from home

Recommendation to work from home where at all possible.

Keep a distance of 1.5 metres to other people



Wash hands regularly and thoroughly
